- ✓ In the past few years the new disruptive lighting technology of Light Emitting Diodes (LED) has changed the focus of specifiers and users of commercial lighting fixtures
- LED technology will deliver savings in energy consumption, maintenance and life cycle costs as the cost of the technology decreases rapidly.
- The LED lighting market is predicted to grow at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 20% from 2011 to 2016.

KEY TALKING POINTS:

- 1. The Company experienced 20% annual growth until the financial meltdown 5 years ago.
- 2. Over the last year, the Department of Energy and several states have mandated all commercial buildings must implement and install energy saving technology. Lighting is the second largest user of electricity in a building.
- 3. This is creating a future boom for LED lighting technology in addition to dramatic improvements with LED technology.
- 4. The primary developers of high-end architectural LED lighting are based in Europe and Asia. Energie has partnered with the principal LED manufacturers and has exclusive North American distribution rights. The Company's corporate offices are in Wheat Ridge, Colorado and has an assembly facility in Michigan where it retrofits the European and Asian fixtures to meet US electrical requirements.
